a free, social skills program for youth aged 12-17. It encourages young people to think and act positively, build self-esteem and learn healthy coping strategies in a safe environment with other youth.

Topics include:

- Communication
- Decision Making
- Goal Setting
- Alcohol and other Drugs
- Coping Skills
- Relationships
- Self-Respect
- Social Media

Group sessions are held every week for 10 weeks and are supported by volunteer community role models.
